CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

Legislative and Executive Relations

- Serve as agency liaison with Governor's, Lt. Governor's, and Speaker's offices
- •Brief legislators and staff on agency activities
- Prepare and distribute RRC Energy Minute for members of the Texas Legislature and Texas Congressional Delegation
- Serve as intergovernmental liaison with partner local, state, and federal agencies

Legislative Tracking & Implementation

- •Identify, track, and analyze state and federal legislation affecting agency operations and industries within RRC jurisdiction
- Facilitate development of agency's legislative agenda

- •Coordinate agency testimony relating to proposed bills and energy-related issues
- •Monitor agency implementation of bills approved in prior legislative sessions

Constituent Affairs

- Respond to legislative and congressional inquiries relating to agency functions
- •Assists legislative and state leadership offices in responding to constituent inquiries
