(Online Inspection Lookup)



For the first time in RRC history, the public can search agency records of oil and gas well inspections and violations online. Launched in January 2019, and seven months ahead of schedule, RRC OIL enables members of the public to look up agency inspection and enforcement reports for wells across Texas, including notices of violation and intentions to sever leases. The information on RRC OIL refreshes daily, allowing users to customize contemporary inspection and violation searches by operator name, lease number, county and, among other criteria, inspection date range. Creating this tool for transparency has long been a priority for the RRC and was an important Sunset Commission recommendation in 2017.

The RRC's Public Geographic Information System Map (GIS) is our most popular website tool. With a few clicks, anyone can locate any oil or gas well, along with intrastate pipelines in Texas. The RRC provides this tool at no cost to the public. In February 2019, we upgraded its capability to identify so users can more quickly and easily research information on multiple wells. Not only does this feature enhance transparency, it reduces the time it takes members of the public, RRC staff, and the energy industry to conduct important research.
